

INVITATION TO BID

The Ozark Foothills Regional Planning Commission will be accepting bid proposals for renovations building improvements to the Ozark Foothills Recycle Center in Poplar Bluff, Mo until October 14th, 2026 at 11:00 am CST. Sealed bid proposals shall be delivered to the Ozark Foothills Regional Planning Commission at 3019 Fair St. Poplar Bluff Mo 63901. Proposals shall be labeled as follows:

BID PROPOSAL: OZARK REGIONAL RECYCLE CENTER

A public bid opening will be held promptly at October 14th, 2026 at 11:00 am CST at the Ozark Foothills Regional Planning Commission at 3019 Fair St. Poplar Bluff Mo 63901. A pre-bid conference will be held at 11:00 am on September 24th at the Ozark Foothills Recycling Center located at 1625 Rowe Pkwy, Poplar Bluff Mo 63901. Bidding General Contractors and interested sub-contractors are encouraged to attend.

Electronic Bid Documents (Plans and Project Manual) will be available free of charge on September 15th through the online plan room of the Architect at www.dillepollard.com; or by contacting Annie Criddle (573-339-4536 or criddle@dillepollard.com). Printed copies will be available with notice upon request for a non-refundable fee of \$50.00 for each set of Bid Documents. Checks are to be made payable to the Architect. Plans may be shipped for a non-refundable charge of \$25.00. All addenda will be issued to all plan holders that have obtained their access of documents through the office of the Architect. It is the bidder's responsibility to verify if any addenda has been issued.

To be considered, bids must be made in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders included in the Project Manual. Each bidder must submit a Surety Bid Bond in the amount of (5%) five percent of their bid amount. The selected General Contractor will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Surety Bonds for the full amount of the Contract and shall include this cost in their bid. Ozark Foothills Regional Planning Commission is a Tax-Exempt Agency; sales tax shall not be included in any bid. All bids must be on a lump sum basis for each section of work; segregated bids will not be accepted. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of (60) sixty days after the bid date. The Owner will evaluate bids based on the best interest of the Owner and will award the project to the lowest and best qualified bidder.

The Owner maintains the right to approve any and all sub-contractors and reserves the right to waive irregularities and to reject any and all bids.

MBE, WBE and Section 3-DBE bidders are encouraged to bid.

Attention is called to the provision for equal employment opportunity and payment of not less than the minimum wages as set forth in the Bid Package. Davis Bacon and Missouri State Wage Rates shall apply.
